Policy on Scholarships and Freeships

(Approved by the Moran College Governing Body meeting held on 14th June 2019)

Introduction

Moran College is a pioneer institution of higher learning located in the heart of Moranhat town, Charaideo district of Assam. The college attracts large number of students from the neighbouring regions and districts. The students enrolled in the college mostly belong to remote villages and socio-economically backward families. Considering the economic conditions of the students, the college has formulated a policy to provide scholarships and freeships to the students belonging to the BPL (Below Poverty Line) category on merit basis (under Students' Aid Fund).

Objective of Policy

- > To facilitate students to avail various Scholarship and Freeships Schemes
- To help the students to apply for scholarships at various levels (Central Government, State Government level)
- Scrutinise the documents for the various scholarship schemes
- Receive and verify the scholarship applications and recommend them forward at the National Scholarship Portal.

Policy Design and Implementation

To fulfill the above objectives, the College appoints a Nodal Officer to look after the various scholarship schemes (Central Government, State Government Scholarships). The Nodal Officer verifies the application forms and supportive documents. The institution functions for dissemination of information regarding various government scholarship schemes. The aspirants of Government scholarships apply directly for the scheme on National Scholarship Portal (<u>https://scholarships.gov.in/</u>) and verifies the application of these students. The students after final verification in the portal received the amount of scholarship directly by ECS to their declared bank accounts.

The students of the institution applied for the following scholarship schemes:

- Ishan Uday Special Scholarship Scheme for North Eastern Region
- Post Matric Scholarship for OBC Students
- Post Matric Scholarship for SC Students
- Post Matric Scholarship for ST Students
- Central Sector Scheme of Scholarships for College and University Students
- Financial Support to The Students of NER for Higher Professional Courses (NEC Merit Scholarship)

The institution verifies the economic status of merit students for BPL Fee Waiver Scheme at the time of admission by the appointment of an Admission Committee. The committee members verifies essentially the Family Income Certificate and Unique ID document of the students at the time of admission to avail them for BPL freeship scheme. The Principal of the college finally verify the BPL list and send it to the Department of Higher Education for availability of Fee Waiver Scheme for BPL merit students.
