



MORAN COLLEGE

AN OVERVIEW:

Established in 1964 the college was started with 68 students – 60 boys and 8 girls. It got approval for opening pre university classes from Gauhati university on 23rd May 1964 and finally got Deficit Grant College Status from the Govt. in 1974. Since 1985 the college has been imparting higher education at degree level in both the Arts and Science stream having Core as well as Major courses.

Moran college is situated in the heart of the Moran town, under the jurisdiction of Charaideo District. Charaideo, a historically important place where the 1st King of Ahom Kingdom "Sargadeo \Chukapha" established the capital, enrichead with the vast treasure of minerals (including Oil, Natural Gas), heavy concentration of tea plantation, the locality also enjoys a unique place in the field of culture, art & literature. Moran town is located at 27.180N 94.930E. The Moran College is well linked by roads, rails ,air ways. The National Highway No.37 passes through the Moran Town.The Moran Rly Station is at 1KM from Moran College whereas The Dibrugarh Airport is at 53 KM away from Moran College.

The college celebrated it's Silver Jubilee in 1989 and Golden Jubilee in 2014 with many colourful programmes and academic activities.

NAAC has visited the college for two times. In its first visit, NAAC accredited the college "B" in the year 2005 and Re-Accrediated 'B Grade ' in 2012.

ACADEMIC SCENARIO:

The college through the various academic departments is imparting higher education. There are 9 departments in Arts Stream (Assamese, Economics, Education, English, History, Geography, Philoshophy, Political Science, Sociology) and 6 departments in Science Stream (Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Computer Science) leading to the B. A. B., Sc, B. Sc.(IT) degrees under semester system in the choice based credit system.

Besides teaching the above mentioned courses, it also offers P.G. Degree Course in Assamese and Graduation in all subjects (Major - Economics, Political Science, Assamese, Sociology, Core-in all subjects) under Dibrugarh University in distance mode, It encourages computer literacy programme by introducing 1 month CLP, 2 months CCA, 6 months DCA, 6 months Web Technology, 6months DDTP, 1 Year Advance diploma in Computer Application.

It is a co-educational institution with more than 3000 students enrolled in various courses

LIBRARY:

There is a Central Library in Moran College, christened as "Moran College Library" with a present holding of 33096 books (as on 23.05.2023) including some rare publications, 14 journals, 7 Magazines along with 19,210 nos of reference books in Humanities Subjects as well as Science. The teaching departments also have their own separate Departmental Libraries. Students can avail books from central library as well as from departmental libraries. The central library can provide 100 seats for reading accomodation at a time.

There is a special Book Bank Facility for economically poor students. In no case a student can keep a book for more than one week, but can renew it just before the date of return, which is mentioned in the date slip. After that if he/she doesnot return the book within that period a fine of 25 (twenty five) paise per day up to 15 days and rupee 1.00 per day thereafter will be imposed. Xerox Facilities are available at the college library. Only the college library books may be xeroxed. Rs. 1/- will be charged per page. 



General Rules for maintenance of Discipline Among Students :

The students admitted to the college must abide by rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authorities. Violation of rules, unsatisfactory

progress, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of hostel fees, showing discourtesy to the teachers and staff members in any form, adoption of unfair means in examination hall etc. are some of the offences which may make students liable for disciplinary action like termination of scholarship, restricted from the classes, forced transfer and even expulsion from the college and

hostel, expulsion from sitting in the final examination.

Students union is subjected to certain guidance and control as the college administration may prescribe from time to time. Any notice desired to be pasted or circulated by the students anywhere in the college and hostel premises shall require the approval of the Principal.

All powers for maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal and his/her decision Will be final in such matter.

ATTENDANCE:

- A student shall have to obtain the required 75% of attendance as per rules of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Coun-cil and Dibrugarh University as the case may be.
- A student who attends at least 60% of the lectures delivered shall however, be allowed to appear in examination as a non-collegiate candidate on payment of prescribed fee.
- A student failing to acquire the minimum precentage of attendance i.e. 60% shall be declared as discollegiate and shall be de barred from appearing in the final examination.
- A student must attend all practical classes and perform all practicals as required under the regulations.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Students seeking admission to the college shall have to obtain a prescribed form available in the college office on payment of Rs. 200.00 (Two hundred) only. The last date for submission of duly filled-in-forms will be notified later on. Following are the documents, the attested copies of which are to be submitted and the original ones are to be produced at the time of interview and admission:
- Mark sheet and the pass crtificate of the qualifying examination attested by the Head of the institution last attested. (It is to be noted that attested copies of marks sheets of the H.S.L.C. exam. Should also be sumitted for admission into B.A./ BSc.
- Two recent passport size photographs.
- Applicants seeking admission under reservation of SC.ST. (P&H) OBC.TGL shall have to enclose certificates from competent authorities.
- The scrutiny of form and selection of students there of shall be made by a Selection Board constituted by the Principal of the college and a list of Provisionally selected students shall be displayed in the notice board.

B.A./B.SC. COURSE:

The college as per the direction of the affiliating University that is 'Dibrugarh University' has adopted Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) from this academic year. Choice based credit system is a flexible system of learning 'Credit' defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the numbers of hours of instruction required. This system permits students to -

- * Learn at their own pace.
- * Choose electives from a wide range of Elective Courses Offered for the programme
- * Undergo additional courses and acquire more than the required number of credits.
- * Adopt an inter-disciplinary approach in learning.
- * Make best use of the expertise of available faculty
- * The qualifying examination is H.S. or equivalent (class twelve)
- * While filling up forms for admission, applicants should be very careful. Before filling up forms, they should read subject combinations properly. In indication preferences for Honours subjects, they should pay due attention to the criteria for admission. A candidate is debarred from submitting more than one application form. If any candidate is found submitting more than one application, his/her candidature will not be considered for admission into the college. However, a candidate can fill up one form for Science and an other for Arts stream.

SCIENCE FACULTY:

It is comprised of the following departments Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Botany, Zoology, Computer Science. A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Educational Council, or an equivalent examination (10 + 2) recognized as such by is eligible for B.Sc.

For admission into the B.Sc., In Chemistry and Physics Honours, a candidate must pass the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science Stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or an equivalent examination with passing Mathematics as a subject.
